### How to Receive Communion More Worthily:

We prepare to receive Communion throughout the Mass.

**The Eucharistic Prayer.** That prayer is an offering of praise and thanksgiving for God's work of creation and salvation. It is a proclamation in which the Body and Blood of Christ are made present by the power of the Holy Spirit and in which we are joined to Christ in offering sacrifice to God the Father.

**The Our Father,** In this prayer we ask God not only to help us in our need but also to purify us from sin, so that what is holy will be given to those who are holy.

**The Sign of Peace.** If we are truly to be made one in Christ through the Eucharist, we must first be at peace with one another.

**Approaching the Altar.** We bow our head & say "Amen" to acknowledge our belief in the Real Presence of Christ.

**Love and Thanksgiving.** During our prayer afterwards, we express our love and thanks to Jesus for letting us receive this great gift.

### LIVING FAITH REFLECTION

#### Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time.

*Jesus said to (Bartimaeus) in reply, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man replied to him, "Master, I want to see." (Mark 10:51)*

Periodically we need to hear a gospel like today's. We need to enter into it. We need to identify with Bartimaeus, begging on the side of the road. We need to sense that Jesus is passing by in this Mass, in this assembly of yearners and believers. The truth is, if we will admit it, that in some areas of the heart, in some areas of the spirit, like the apostles in Mark, we have misunderstood Jesus and his message, that we have spiritual blind spots.

But Jesus in this Mass is calling us. "What do you want me to do for you?" he asks. Right away we can think of a million things, but surely a more true, more reflective response should be that of Bartimaeus: "Lord, I want to see."

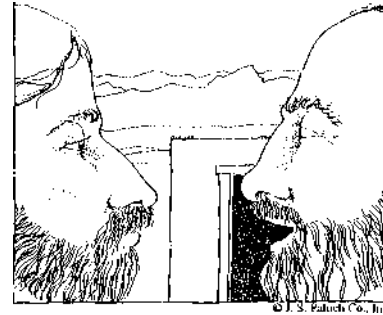
